A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF MX908 HANDHELD HIGH-PRESSURE MASS SPECTROMETERS (HPMS™) AND ASSOCIATED ITEMS FOR THE FIRE AND POLICE DEPARTMENTS, FROM 908 DEVICES INC., OF BOSTON, MASSACHUSETTS, UTILIZING LOWER PRICING THAN THE GSA CONTRACT NO. GS-075-100GA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Centers for Disease Control Prevention (CDC) issued a Notice of Award to the Department of Health (Department) to fund the Overdose Data to Action (OD2A) Surveillance and Prevention Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, a “Memorandum of Agreement between State of Florida, Department of Health Broward County Health Department and City of Sunrise” for the Acceptance of the Overdose Data to Action (OD2A) Surveillance and Prevention Implementation Program Grant Award was approved on June 22, 2021 by the City Commission under Resolution No. 21-66 for Sunrise Fire Rescue and a second agreement with that name was approved under Resolution No. 21-67 for Sunrise Police; and

WHEREAS, the Memoranda of Agreement require the purchase of Portable Mass Spectrometers to improve opioid drug surveillance; and

WHEREAS, these purchases will be made from the manufacturer who is sole service provider for the product offered and the only authorized point of service, support and maintenance for these systems including certified training, warranty, repair upgrades and technical support, using lower pricing than an existing governmental contract.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby ratified and incorporated as the legislative intent of this Resolution.

Section 2. The purchase of MX908 handheld high-pressure mass spectrometers and associated items, in the total amount of \$73,293.88 for the Fire Department and \$73,338.21 for the Police Department from 908 Devices Inc. is hereby approved.

Section 3. Pursuant to Section 5-173(c)(5) of the Code of the City of Sunrise Florida, the City's formal bidding procedures are waived for good cause for the reasons set forth in this Resolution and accompanying Agenda Item Request.

Section 4. The Procurement Manager or designee is hereby authorized to issue Purchase Orders or take other action necessary in connection with this award.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
