**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA, APPROVING
AN "INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN BROWARD COUNTY AND
CITY OF SUNRISE FOR COST SHARE SUPPORT OF A WATER
CONSERVATION INCENTIVES PROGRAM;" AND PROVIDING AN
EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, demands for water conservation remain intense in the face of sea level rise and impacts of saltwater intrusion of the Biscayne Aquifer, local population growth, and constraints on regional water supply; and

WHEREAS, the least expensive and immediate alternative for expanding our water supply is by reducing water use; and

WHEREAS, by entering into a cost share support Interlocal Agreement with Broward County, we partner with the County in a community-wide Water Conservation and Incentives Program to educate and encourage residents and businesses to adopt an enduring water conservation ethic that supports long-term water resource sustainability, and to offer incentives on water saving devices and fixtures to achieve this goal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. An "Interlocal Agreement between Broward County and City of Sunrise for Cost Share Support of a Water Conservation Incentives Program" (Interlocal Agreement) is hereby approved. A copy of the Interlocal Agreement is attached hereto and made a part of this Resolution as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Mayor and City Manager are hereby authorized to execute the Interlocal Agreement.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
