A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF A WEATHER SAFETY SYSTEM FROM PERRY WEATHER, INC.; APPROVING AN “ORDER FORM” AND INCORPORATED TERMS AND CONDITIONS BETWEEN THE CITY OF SUNRISE AND PERRY WEATHER, INC.; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, due to the City of Sunrise’s continued growth, the increase in outdoor sports and other outdoor activities, and frequent and severe storms, there is a need for more effective weather warning and lightning detection systems in the City; and

WHEREAS, after thorough research, City staff has identified and recommends the replacement of the City’s current weather safety system with the Perry Weather Complete Weather Safety System at outdoor locations throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, Perry Weather, Inc. has offered the City comparable contract terms and more favorable pricing for the Perry Weather Complete Weather Safety System compared to existing contracts competitively solicited by other governmental purchasing cooperatives and entities, including the BuyBoard Purchasing Cooperative and The Interlocal Purchasing System (TIPS).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby ratified and incorporated as the legislative intent of this Resolution.

Section 2. The Perry Weather “Order Form” and incorporated Terms and Conditions between the City of Sunrise and Perry Weather, Inc. (collectively, the “Agreement”) for the purchase of a Weather Safety System are hereby approved in an amount not to exceed the FY 2025/2026 approved budgeted funds, with subsequent years’ expenditures subject to budget approval. A copy of the Agreement is attached hereto and made a part of this Resolution as Exhibit A.

Section 3. Because this purchase will be made utilizing terms comparable to, and pricing more favorable than, existing governmental contracts resulting from competitive solicitation, the City’s formal bidding procedures are hereby waived pursuant to Section 5-173(c)(4) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Sunrise, Florida.

Section 4. The Procurement Manager or designee is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement and any associated documents necessary for the full and complete performance of the Agreement. The Procurement Manager or designee is further authorized to extend, amend, or renew the Agreement in accordance with the terms of the approved Agreement.

Section 5. The City Manager and the Director of Leisure Services are hereby authorized to approve change orders provided the aggregate amount of the change orders do not exceed \$24,999.99. The Director of Leisure Services shall provide the City Clerk with copies of any approved change orders.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
