Whereas, student leaders do not automatically develop sound leadership skills and require trained, dedicated faculty advisers to help young people develop the essential traits and characteristics of a leader and to provide the positive experiences necessary to expand their skills and foster their paths to becoming effective leaders; and

Whereas, the support of school administrators and faculty, parents, and community members is necessary to help ensure the successful education of emerging student leaders; and

Whereas, it is vital we encourage the active engagement of all students within their communities, in hopes that they will develop a life-long commitment to community service and government participation; and

Whereas, Student Government Day serves as an ideal time to bring attention to the important and integral contributions that student leaders and leadership training makes in our schools.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Michael J. Ryan, Mayor of the City of Sunrise, Florida, along with the City Commissioners hereby proclaim Wednesday, May 27th, 2026 as:
