A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT AMONG BROWARD COUNTY AND PARTICIPATING MUNICIPALITIES FOR SHARING RESOURCE BURDENS OF THE SYSTEM-WIDE NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) MUNICIPAL SEPARATE STORM SEWER SYSTEM (MS4) PERMIT AND AUTHORIZING BROWARD COUNTY TO CONDUCT TECHNICAL ACTIVITIES REQUIRED BY THE PERMIT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), pursuant to the Water Pollution Control Act (“Clean Water Act”) and related regulations, requires the County and municipalities to comply with the conditions of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) Permit Program; and

WHEREAS, the EPA has recommended that the Broward County Public Works and Environmental Services Department (PWESD) act as the “lead permittee” and the participating municipalities act as “co-permittees”; and

WHEREAS, Broward County, through the PWESD, coordinates and conducts specific technical activities required by the NPDES MS4 Permit; and

WHEREAS, since 1996, the County and participating municipalities have been parties to Interlocal Agreements to carry out tasks required by the NPDES MS4 Permit; the current Interlocal Agreement expires on September 30, 2026; and

WHEREAS, continued participation as a co-permittee provides cost savings to the City by leveraging joint County-wide resources, eliminating the duplication of local sampling efforts, and ensuring regulatory compliance; and

WHEREAS, an Interlocal Agreement between the County and participating municipalities is required for the PWESD to continue to manage and perform the technical tasks necessary to comply with the NPDES MS4 Permit.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. An “Interlocal Agreement among Broward County and the Municipalities of Coconut Creek, Cooper City, Coral Springs, Dania Beach, Davie, Deerfield Beach,

Hallandale Beach, Lauderdale-By-The-Sea, Lauderdale Lakes, Lauderdale Hill, Lighthouse Point, Margate, Miramar, North Lauderdale, Oakland Park, Parkland, Pembroke Park, Pembroke Pines, Plantation, Pompano Beach, Southwest Ranches, Sunrise, Tamarac, Weston, West Park, and Wilton Manors for Sharing Resource Burdens of the System-Wide NPDES MS4 Permit and Authorizing Broward County to Conduct Technical Activities Required by the NPDES MS4 Permit” (Interlocal Agreement) is hereby approved. A copy of the Interlocal Agreement is attached hereto and made a part of this Resolution as Exhibit “A”.

Section 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the Interlocal Agreement.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
