**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA, APPROVING
AN “AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA AND
BOYS & GIRLS CLUBS OF BROWARD COUNTY, INC.”; AND
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, as a part of the Fiscal Year 2022 Budget, the City Commission allocated American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Funds for City Commission priority projects and programs; and

WHEREAS, in 2023, the City partnered with the Boys & Girls Clubs of Broward County, Inc. (BGCBC) to provide teen services at Roarke Hall, to include education, social, recreation, health, physical education, leadership and citizenship development, cultural enrichment, and personal adjustment with one-on one counseling; and

WHEREAS, due to the success of this partnership, the City wishes to continue to work with BGCBC in providing these essential services.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The foregoing Whereas clauses are hereby ratified and incorporated as the legislative intent of this Resolution.

Section 2. The “Agreement between the City of Sunrise, Florida and the Boys & Girls Clubs of Broward County, Inc.” (Agreement) is hereby approved. A copy of the Agreement is attached hereto and made a part of this Resolution as Exhibit A.

Section 3. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement.

Section 4. The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute all documents and take other actions necessary to carry out the Agreement and this Resolution. Any material amendments to the Agreement require approval of the City Commission.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
