A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA, APPROVING A “LETTER OF AGREEMENT AND CONTRACT” BETWEEN THE CITY OF SUNRISE AND THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH FLORIDA TRAINING AND SERVICES INSTITUTE, INC., D/B/A INSTITUTE OF POLICE TECHNOLOGY AND MANAGEMENT FOR A PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE SAFETY HIGH VISIBILITY ENFORCEMENT GRANT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Sunrise Police Department has been awarded a grant from the University of North Florida Training and Services Institute to provide for payment of overtime costs related to pedestrian and bicycle safety education and enforcement; and

WHEREAS, an agreement between the parties is required for the acceptance of the grant.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. A “Letter of Agreement and Contract” between the City of Sunrise and the University of North Florida Training and Services Institute, Inc., d/b/a Institute of Police Technology and Management (Agreement) is hereby approved. A copy of the Agreement is attached hereto and made a part of this Resolution as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Chief of Police is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement.

Section 3. The Chief of Police, or designee, is hereby authorized to perform all acts required for the full performance of the Agreement, including executing any related documents, reports, extensions, or renewals. Any extension or renewal requires the approval of the City Attorney’s Office. Any material amendment to the Agreement, other than an increase to the grant amount, requires approval of the City Commission. The Chief of Police shall provide the City Clerk with a copy of any executed amendment, extension, or renewal.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
