**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING
ADDITIONAL EXPENDITURES FOR MEDICAL SERVICES FROM
SOLANTIC/SOUTH FLORIDA, LLC D/B/A CARESPOT EXPRESS
HEALTHCARE IN EXCESS OF THE PROCUREMENT MANAGER'S
AUTHORITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the City utilizes Solantic/South Florida, LLC d/b/a Carespot Express Healthcare for medical background services, pre-employment physicals, immunizations, drug testing and other medical services on an as needed basis; and

WHEREAS, due to the increased number of citywide requests during FY 2025-2026, expenditures for medical services will exceed the Procurement Manager's current \$24,999.00 purchasing authority.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby ratified and incorporated as the legislative intent of this Resolution.

Section 2. The purchase of medical services from Solantic/South Florida, LLC d/b/a Carespot Express Healthcare (Carespot) in excess of the Procurement Manager's purchasing authority of \$24,999.00 is hereby approved in an amount not to exceed the FY 2025-2026 approved budgeted funds.

Section 3. Pursuant to Section 5-173(c)(6) of the Code of the City of Sunrise, Florida, the City's formal bidding procedures are waived for the purchase of medical services.

Section 4. The Procurement Manager or designee is hereby authorized to issue a Purchase Order or take other action necessary in connection with this purchase.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
