**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA, APPROVING
EXPENDITURES AND DONATIONS FROM THE STATE
CONFISCATION AND FORFEITURE FUND (196) IN THE AMOUNT OF
\$25,000.00 FOR APPROVED LAW ENFORCEMENT PROGRAMS; AND
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 932.7055(5), Florida Statutes, forfeiture proceeds shall be deposited in a special law enforcement trust fund and used for school resource officer, crime prevention, safe neighborhood, drug abuse education and prevention programs, or for other law enforcement purposes; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 932.7055(5), Florida Statutes, law enforcement agencies that acquire at least \$15,000 within a fiscal year are required to expend or donate no less than twenty-five percent (25%) of forfeiture proceeds for the support or operation of any drug treatment, drug abuse education, drug prevention, crime prevention, safe neighborhood, or school resource officer programs; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has certified that the donations set forth in the attached Exhibit A "Donations from the Forfeiture Funds FY 25/26" comply with state law.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Expenditures and donations from the State Confiscation and Forfeiture Fund (196) in the amount of \$25,000.00 for law enforcement purposes and programs meeting the requirements of Section 932.7055(5), Florida Statutes, as set forth in the attached Exhibit A "Donations from the Forfeiture Funds FY 25/26" are hereby approved.

Section 2. The Chief of Police shall ensure that all requirements of the Florida Contraband Forfeiture Act are met.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
