**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA, APPOINTING A
HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT TO THE SUSTAINABILITY ADVISORY
BOARD AS AN EX-OFFICIO MEMBER FOR A TERM THROUGH JUNE
30, 2027; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, on November 9, 2010 the City Commission created a Sustainability Advisory Board comprised of nine (9) members. In addition, a high school student serving as an ex-officio, non-voting member shall be appointed to the Board; and

WHEREAS, the high school student position is currently vacant and the City has received two (2) applications to fill that position; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends that the applicant selected is appointed for a term to end June 30, 2027, to coincide with the applicant's high school graduation date.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Pursuant to Section 2-250.9 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Sunrise, Florida (City Code), applicant _____ is hereby selected to become the ex-officio high school student member of the City of Sunrise Sustainability Advisory Board for a term through June 30, 2027.

Section 2. Pursuant to Section 2-250.9 of the City Code, the high school student member shall be an ex-officio, non-voting member of the Board, shall not receive compensation, and shall not receive reimbursement of expenses under Section 2-78 of the City Code.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
