A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA, APPOINTING MEMBERS TO THE UNSAFE STRUCTURES BOARD; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on June 10, 2008, the City Commission created the Unsafe Structures Board (Board); and

WHEREAS, there are currently vacancies on the Board for the disciplines of real estate property manager, registered engineer, and registered architect. The term for the real estate property manager expires December 31, 2027, and the terms for the registered architect and registered engineer expire December 31, 2028; and

WHEREAS, after extensive advertising and solicitation of various professionals, applications were submitted for consideration for placement on the Board; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has reviewed all applications and is ready to appoint members to this Board.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Pursuant to Section 2-246 of the Code of the City of Sunrise, Florida, the following applicants in the identified disciplines are hereby selected to become members of the City of Sunrise's Unsafe Structures Board for a term beginning immediately and ending as referenced below, or until the member's successor is appointed:

1.	Real Estate Property Manager	December 31, 2027
2.	Registered Architect	December 31, 2028
3.	Registered Engineer	December 31, 2028

Section 2. Pursuant to Section 2-78 of the Code of the City of Sunrise, Florida, and Resolution No. 08-152, as amended, voting members of City of Sunrise Boards shall be reimbursed for expenses incurred in connection with Board business at a rate of fifty

dollars (\$50.00) per meeting attended, not to exceed twelve (12) such reimbursements during each fiscal year.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
