ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE
ESTABLISHING A MEMORIAL TREE PROGRAM;
PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION
IN THE CODE AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Sunrise is committed to a continuing program of city beautification; and

WHEREAS, this City Council recognizes that there are individuals who desire to donate funds in memory of loved ones who have passed on; and

WHEREAS, in furthering the above purposes and interests, this Council wishes to establish a Memorial Tree Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. This Council hereby creates and establishes a Memorial Tree Program whereby residents may donate funds to the City for the purchase and planting, of trees in memory of a loved one.

Section 2. Pursuant to aforesaid program, trees shall be planted in City parks, median strips and on other City owned property.

Section 3. An individual desiring to have a tree planted in memory of a loved one shall donate \$100.00 for the purchase of the tree and shall be entitled to choose, subject to availability, the species of tree to be purchased from the City's approved tree list.

Section 4. The donor shall have the right to request a site on which the tree may be planted, which shall, however, be subject to final approval by the City Engineer.

Section 5. Each donor shall be recognized on an honor roll which shall be maintained in the City Hall of the City of Sunrise and each donor shall receive from the City a certificate of appreciation.

Section 6. The City Public Works Department shall accept applications and administer the Memorial Tree Program.

Section 7. Severability. Should any provision of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not effect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof to be invalid.

Section 8. Inclusion In The Code. It is the intention of the City Council, and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and made a part of the Code of the City of Sunrise, Florida; that the sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intentions; and that the word "Ordinance" may be changed to "Section" or other appropriate word.


Section 9. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its execution by the Mayor, which shall be the date of passage or adoption by the City Council unless otherwise indicated in writing hereon above the Mayor's signature, or on the eleventh day after the date of passage or adoption by the City Council if not then signed or vetoed by the Mayor, which shall be certified hereon by the City Clerk. Upon its adoption and from and after its effective date, this Ordinance, unless and until repealed, shall have full force and effect as a law of the City of Sunrise and shall constitute public notice of the provisions thereof to all persons effected thereby as provided by law.

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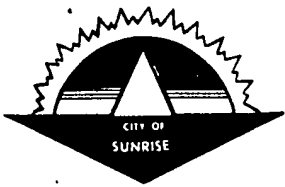

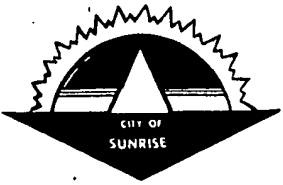
