Section 1. A Summer Camp Late Pick-up charge is hereby established in the Leisure Services Department's Schedule of Fees as follows:



The facility must be returned to substantially the same condition that existed just prior to the start of the event for the deposit to be refunded.

Section 4. All fees charged by the Leisure Services Department now in effect shall remain in effect for activities which do not constitute official meetings of a



After the recently held budget workshop meetings, we, as a City Department, followed directives to bring recreation fees and charges "up to date".

Hall rental fees were adjusted as follows:

In raising the fees, we took the following into consideration:

- a. Electric bills for Roarke Center for the past five months average \$426.00 per month. Water Bill = \$50.00 monthly.  
  
Electric bills for Whiting Hall for the past five months averaged \$475.00. Water and gas bill - \$75.00 monthly.
- b. Whiting Hall, starting in September, has approximately doubled in size. Thus, we are informed that the utility bills will almost double. Air conditioners have been added and eleven fluorescent fixtures have been installed.
- c. Upkeep of both facilities averages an additional \$150.00 monthly. If the halls are left in an unusual mess, additional charges are incurred.

\*We are presently negotiating a new cleaning fee for this facility due to the fact that the hall has almost doubled in size.

If we were to rent Whiting Hall for 25 out of 30 evenings per month, at \$20.00 per meeting we would generate \$500.00 in revenue. Add to that, 15 daytime meetings at \$15.00 and we have an additional \$225.00 totaling the income for Whiting (on an average) at
