ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 782-X, AS AMENDED, BY CREATING AND REVISING PROGRAM FEES IN THE LEISURE SERVICES FEE SCHEDULE; BY RELOCATING AND ADJUSTING CERTAIN FEES, PROGRAMS AND MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES; AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF LEISURE SERVICES TO IMPLEMENT OR AMEND VARIOUS PROGRAMS AND FEES; REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 697-X; REPEALING VARIOUS RESOLUTIONS WHICH IMPLEMENTED OR AMENDED LEISURE SERVICES FEES; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Leisure Services Department's Fee Schedule (Fee Schedule) has been approved by the City Commission through a multitude of Ordinances and Resolutions; and

WHEREAS, via Ordinance No. 782-X-19-A, the City consolidated fees from various Ordinances into one (1) controlling Ordinance with numerous schedules attached as exhibits; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 782-X-20-A removed expired fees for the Sunrise Civic Center Athletic Club and amended transportation fees; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 782-X-22-A approved and amended fees incorporated or restated in Exhibits A through E, moved age requirement and rental availability language, and addressed memberships at multiple facilities; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 782-X-23-A approved the Bridges at Springtree Golf Club fees, and incorporated Exhibit F establishing such fees; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 782-X-24-A approved the Veterans Park Memorial Brick Program and associated fees, and incorporated Exhibit G establishing such fees; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 782-X-25-A approved the "Signature Sunrise" Ballroom fees, and incorporated Exhibit H establishing such fees; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to further streamline the Fee Schedule, City staff recommends the consolidation of all existing exhibits to Ordinance No. 782-X, as

amended, into one comprehensive Exhibit A in the form attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends the establishment of various new Departmental fees and programs; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to increase efficiency and meet the evolving needs of the community, City staff requires the ability to establish select fees to meet operational needs; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends the repeal of Ordinance No. 697-X, which established a Memorial Tree Program and associated fees. City staff further recommends the repeal of Resolution Nos. 01-93, 02-17, 02-70, 02-186, 03-28, 03-93, 03-109, 03-109-18-B, 03-124, 03-148, 08-169, 10-15, 75-59, 79-87, 79-95, 85-95, 87-229 and 77-122 in their entirety as the fees established therein will now be set forth in the attached Exhibit A.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The foregoing Whereas clauses are hereby ratified and incorporated as the legislative intent of this Ordinance.

Section 2. All rates for fees established by Ordinance No. 782-X, as amended, are hereby repealed in their entirety and replaced with Exhibit A, which is attached hereto and made a part of this Ordinance.

Section 3. Any adjustments to the fees identified in Exhibit A may be approved by resolution of the City Commission after an advertised public hearing in accordance with Section 2-317 of the Code of the City of Sunrise, Florida.

Section 4. Fees for the rental of facilities as set forth in Exhibit A may be waived by resolution upon the City Commission's determination that a municipal public purpose exists, as previously authorized pursuant to Ordinance No. 782-X-22-A. Additionally, the City Commission determines that a municipal public purpose exists and determines that the Director of Leisure Services or designee may waive fees set forth in Exhibit A for meetings among government entities; for meetings among representatives or employees of government entities; for meetings of state, regional, or national organizations which promote the exchange of ideas between, or the professional development of, government officials or employees, and whose membership is primarily composed of elected or appointed public officials or public employees; and for trainings of City of Sunrise employees.

Section 5. Resolution No. 08-169, authorizing the Director of Leisure Services to

waive facility rental fees for official meetings of civic organizations including, but not limited to, nonprofit condominium associations, political clubs, fraternal orders, charitable organizations, athletic clubs, homeowners' associations, and similar organizations located within the City, as determined by the Director of Leisure Services, is hereby reaffirmed and ratified.

Section 6. The Director of Leisure Services, or designee, is hereby authorized to:

- Implement various programs and classes operated by City employees at a cost not to exceed \$50.00 per session;
- Implement various Theatre shows and programs in an amount not to exceed \$50.00 per ticket;
- Implement adult sports programs at a cost not to exceed \$50.00 for an individual or \$500.00 for a team;
- Establish an activity fee assistance program;
- Establish procedures for the Memorial Tree Program; and
- Establish and amend concession fees.

Section 7. Repeal of Ordinance No. 697-X. Ordinance No. 697-X, which established a Memorial Tree Program, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 8. Repeal of Resolutions Establishing Fees. Resolution Nos. 01-93, 02-17, 02-70, 02-186, 03-28, 03-93, 03-109, 03-109-18-b, 03-124, 03-148, 08-169, 10-15, 75-59, 79-87, 79-95, 85-95, 87-229 and 77-122 are hereby repealed in their entirety as the fees established therein will now be set forth in the attached Exhibit A.

Section 9. Conflict. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, all City Code sections or parts of City Code sections, and all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 10. Severability. Should any provision of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part declared to be invalid.

Section 11. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The fees established by this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage, with the exception of fees which have been advertised at a previous rate.
