**RESOLUTION NO. \_\_\_\_\_**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF RADIO MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR SERVICES FROM BROWARD COUNTY REGIONAL COMMUNICATIONS AND TECHNOLOGY DIVISION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, in 2013, via Resolution No. 13-142, the City of Sunrise (City) entered into a Regional Interlocal Agreement (RILA) with Broward County to provide for Cooperative Participation in a Regional Public Safety Intranet, which supports closest-unit response in life threatening emergencies, while keeping maintenance of equipment under City responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, in 2013, via Resolution No. 13-143, the City Commission approved an Agreement with Broward County for Participation in the Consolidated Regional E-911 Communications System (E-911 PA) and the migration to the County's computer Aided Dispatch System (CAD); and

WHEREAS, in 2015, via Resolution No.15-103, the City Commission approved an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) with Broward County as to MotoTRBO Equipment, whereby the City assumed maintenance and repairs costs for Motorola radio equipment and which allowed the use of certified Motorola repair facilities and employees authorized by Broward County to program or repair radios that receive or transmit on the system; and

WHEREAS, in 2020, via Resolution No. 13-143-20-A, the City Commission approved a First Amendment to the E-911 PA and the RILA to acknowledge and adopt updates to the Operator Agreement between Broward County and the Broward Sheriff's Office and the operation of the Consolidated Regional E-911 Communications System, and to amend the RILA to remain consistent with the E-911 PA; and

WHEREAS, in 2023, via Resolution No. 13-143-23-A, the City Commission approved a Second Amendment to the E-911 PA and the RILA to extend the terms of those agreements through September 30, 2028; and

WHEREAS, since the approval of the E-911 PA and the RILA, as amended, new equipment has been purchased, numerous radios and equipment are no longer under warranty, the demand for ongoing maintenance and repair services has increased, and the annual expenditures for maintenance and repair services now exceed the Procurement Manager's authority threshold of \$35,000; and

WHEREAS, the use of radios and radio equipment is vital for City personnel, particularly first and emergency responders. The Broward County Regional

Communications and Technology Division provides local support with experienced and certified personnel, and competitive pricing.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby ratified as the legislative intent of this Resolution.

Section 2. The purchase of Radio Maintenance and Repair Services from Broward County Regional Communications and Technology Division is hereby approved in an amount not to exceed the FY 2025-2026 approved budgeted funds, with subsequent years' expenditures subject to budget approval.

Section 3. The Procurement Manager or designee is hereby authorized to issue Purchase Orders or take other action necessary in connection with these purchases.

Section 4. Pursuant to Section 5-173(c)(6) of the Code of the City of Sunrise, Florida, the City's formal bidding procedures are hereby waived because the services being purchased are provided by another governmental agency.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
