**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA, ENDORSING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE C-13 GREENWAY CONCEPT AND SUPPORTING THE EFFORTS OF THE BROWARD METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION TO PREPARE THE RECOMMENDED CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FOR FEDERAL FUNDING; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, as an active participant in the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO), the City of Sunrise (City) recognizes the importance of collaborative planning to help address current and future transportation demands throughout the County; and

WHEREAS, the City and the MPO agree to collaborate to prepare studies and plans to address transportation needs and land use impacts; and

WHEREAS, the City and the MPO have identified the C-13 Greenway from Hiatus Road to North University Drive as a location for a shared pathway opportunity; and

WHEREAS, the MPO has developed conceptual plans in collaboration with City staff; and

WHEREAS, on July 10, 2025, the MPO conducted an initial public information meeting at the Nob Hill Soccer Complex regarding the proposed C-13 Greenway project; and

WHEREAS, on October 22, 2025, the City and the MPO held a public workshop at the Nob Hill Soccer Complex to introduce the C-13 Greenway Concept to receive public input and request feedback on the preferred alternative; and

WHEREAS, the City and the MPO, with support from the public, selected a Locally Preferred Alternative which maximized separation between the shared use path and the canal; and

WHEREAS, the Locally Preferred Alternative includes a proposed path located along the south side of the C-13 Canal from Hiatus Road to Pine Island Road, where it will cross to the north side of the C-13 Canal and run to North University Drive along the north side of the C-13 Canal as illustrated in Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the C-13 Greenway Conceptual Plans identified capital improvements to enhance connectivity and safety; and

WHEREAS, the C-13 Greenway from Hiatus Road to North University Drive will be constructed within the South Florida Water Management District right of way; and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the City to maintain or coordinate the maintenance of the greenway after the project's completion; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Sunrise finds that the implementation of the C-13 Greenway Conceptual Plans to be in the best interest of the residents of the City of Sunrise.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby ratified and incorporated as the legislative intent of this Resolution.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Sunrise hereby endorses the recommendations of the C-13 Greenway Conceptual Plans for the Locally Preferred Alternative that includes a proposed path located on the south side of the C-13 Canal between Hiatus Road and Pine Island Road, and then transitions to the north side of the C-13 Canal between Pine Island Road and University Drive, and supports the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization's efforts to prepare the recommended capital improvements for federal funding.

Section 3. Severability. Should any provision of this Resolution be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the Resolution as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part declared to be invalid.

Section 4. Conflict. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, all City Code sections or parts of City Code sections, and all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
