Leisure Services Department Fee Schedule

Resident rates listed are to be applied for Residents of the City of Sunrise as well as Sunrise Resident Businesses (including Non-Profits), as verified by the Leisure Services Department. However, businesses and non-profits are eligible only for rentals.

1. Definitions

- 1.1. Resident: A person with primary residency established within the boundaries of the City of Sunrise. Proof of residency, with City of Sunrise address, such as mortgage statement, utility bill, or other documents deemed as appropriate by the Leisure Services Department may be required.
- 1.2. Non-Resident: Any person not meeting the definition of Resident as listed above.
- 1.3. Junior: Any person 17 and under, unless specific ages are outlined.
- 1.4. Senior: Any person 55 and older, unless specific ages are outlined.
- 1.5. Family: Includes up to five members, unless otherwise noted, with two adult parents/guardians and dependent children residing at the same address, subject to verification. Additional adults on a family membership are limited to adult dependent children or a dependent parent living at the same address, subject to verification.
- 1.6. Prevailing Rate: The actual cost of materials, services, and/or supplies, including required administrative and incidental costs incurred.

2. Discounts

- 2.1. Membership: Beyond the first paid membership at the Sunrise Athletic Club, The Bridges at Springtree Golf Club, or the Sunrise Tennis Club, additional memberships are eligible for a stacking 25% discount, up to 50%.
- 2.2. Siblings: Fees listed are for the first child, Residents receive a 10% fee reduction for the second child, and an additional 5% cumulative reduction for each successive immediate family member participating in these programs. Eligible programs are noted by SD in superscript (^{SD}).

14. Recreation Fees for City Employees, Their Immediate Family Members, and Retired Vested City Employees

The following recreation fee schedule for City employees, their immediate family members and retired vested City employees is hereby created to provide as follows:

14.1. Definitions

- 14.1.1. City Employee - All salaried personnel employed by the City of Sunrise.
- 14.1.2. Immediate Family - The son, daughter, stepson, stepdaughter under 18 years of age, and spouse.
- 14.1.3. Retired Vested City Employee - All City employees who are retired from the City of Sunrise and are eligible to receive retirement benefits from the City.

14.2. Use of The Bridges at Springtree Golf Club

- 14.2.1. All City employees and members of their immediate families living in the same household will be eligible for members rates for the use of the Springtree facility. Membership fees will be waived. However, all greens fees, cart fees, and full tournament fees will be applicable.
- 14.2.2. Retired vested City employees will also be eligible for the same privilege as stated above.

14.3. Use of Sunrise Tennis Club

- 14.3.1. City employees and immediate family members living in the same household will be eligible to utilize Sunrise Tennis Club for current member guest fee rates. Membership fees will be waived. However, full tournament entry fees will be applicable.
- 14.3.2. Retired vested City employees will also be eligible for the same privilege as stated above.

14.4. Use of City Swimming Facilities

- 14.4.1. Lunch Time Fitness Swimming
- 14.4.2. Current City employees wishing to utilize City owned swimming facilities for lunch time fitness swimming may do so without charge to the employee. This privilege does not apply to members of the immediate family unless they are also City employees.
- 14.4.3. Use of Swimming Facilities during Regular Operating Hours
 - a. Current City employees and members of the immediate families living in the same household, will be eligible to utilize the City's swimming facilities for one half the established resident fee and nonresident fee as applicable, in accordance with the local address of the employee.

14.5. Participation in City Facility Sports Programs and Recreation Classes Administered Directly by the Department of Leisure Services

- 14.5.1. City Employees and their immediate families living in the same household will be eligible to participate in programs for which there are individual fees for one half the established rate. City employees living inside the City limits will pay one half the resident registration fee and City employees living outside the City limits will be eligible to pay one half the non-resident fee. In some cases shortage of available facilities will result in separate

registration dates for residents and nonresidents. In this case, the restriction to nonresident City employees and their families would apply.

- 14.5.2. In cases where recreation program charges are indicative of separate registration and field trip fees, City employees and members of their immediate families living in the same household will pay the complete cost of established field trip fees which are taxable and charged independently of the registration for the program.

14.6. Contracted Instructor Fees

- 14.6.1. City Employees and members of their Immediate Family living in the same household will pay the full cost of programs that are operated under the Department's auspices by private contracted instructors.

14.7. Rental Fees for Recreation Halls, Swimming Facilities and Pavilions for Private Use

- 14.7.1. City Employees will pay the established fees for private use rentals of the City's recreation facilities. However, in cases where City facilities are being requested by the Department directly to celebrate the retirement or departure of a City employee, fees will be waived for events occurring during normal operating hours.

However, additional direct expenses for required staff supervision costs, clean-up costs, overtime custodial/attendant costs, and all extra costs incurred for using recreational facilities will be charged to the user in order to not adversely impact the overtime and operating budget of the Leisure Services Department.

- 14.8. The individuals indicated in this section shall not charge a third party or use those City facilities for monetary gain.
