A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA, APPROVING A “MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, FLORIDA’S TURNPIKE ENTERPRISE AND CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA REGARDING THE SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY (SR 869) WIDENING PROJECTS”; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the State of Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is finalizing the design of and preparing to advertise the Sawgrass Expressway Widening Project (Project), within the City of Sunrise; and

WHEREAS, the proposed work includes modifications and improvements within City right-of-way for Sawgrass Corporate Parkway, Flamingo Road, and NW 136th Avenue, as well as on parcels along Sawgrass Corporate Parkway that will be conveyed to the City as right-of-way upon completion of the Project; and

WHEREAS, FDOT is responsible for the design, procurement, and construction of improvements including lane widening, milling and resurfacing, stormwater management, lighting, pavement markings, and signage and traffic control signal equipment; and

WHEREAS, upon completion of the Project, certain items within City right-of-way will be maintained by FDOT, and other items will be maintained by the City; and

WHEREAS, a Memorandum of Agreement between FDOT and the City is necessary to delineate the maintenance responsibilities after Project completion.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The “Memorandum of Agreement between Florida Department of Transportation, Florida’s Turnpike Enterprise and City of Sunrise, Florida Regarding the Sawgrass Expressway (SR 869) Widening Projects” (Agreement) is hereby approved. A copy of the Agreement is attached to and made a part of this Resolution as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement.

Section 3. City staff is hereby authorized to take all actions necessary to fully perform the Agreement.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
