A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA, APPROVING A “RETAINER AGREEMENT” BETWEEN THE CITY OF SUNRISE, WEISS SEROTA HELFMAN COLE & BIERMAN, P.L., AND AMERICAN TRAFFIC SOLUTIONS, INC. D/B/A VERRA MOBILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Sunrise requires the services of special appellate counsel to represent the City in the City’s appeal of the trial court ruling in *State of Florida v. Kayla Erin McFadden* and in related proceedings (the “Appeal”); and

WHEREAS, Weiss Serota Helfman Cole & Bierman, P.L. (Weiss Serota) has been selected as special counsel to represent the City in the Appeal and American Traffic Solutions, Inc. d/b/a Verra Mobility (Verra Mobility) has agreed to pay the legal fees incurred in the Appeal; and

WHEREAS, a Retainer Agreement between Weiss Serota, Verra Mobility, and the City is necessary to set forth the terms and conditions related to the legal representation and payment of fees incurred in the Appeal; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission must hire special counsel, and approval is requested to allow the City Attorney to execute a Retainer Agreement between Weiss Serota, Verra Mobility, and the City.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The “Retainer Agreement” between Weiss Serota Helfman Cole & Bierman, P.L., American Traffic Solutions, Inc. d/b/a Verra Mobility, and the City of Sunrise (Agreement) is hereby approved. A copy of the Agreement is attached hereto and made a part of this Resolution as Exhibit A.

Section 2. Pursuant to Section 5-173(c)(6) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Sunrise, Florida, contractual services for legal services are exempt from competitive procurement.

Section 3. The City Attorney is hereby authorized to execute the Retainer Agreement.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
