**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA, APPROVING
“STANDARD CONTRACT NO. C 26-03-04-VH BETWEEN THE CITY OF
SUNRISE, FLORIDA AND TENNIS ENTERPRISES, LLC FOR TENNIS
PROFESSIONAL SERVICES” AT THE SUNRISE TENNIS CLUB; AND
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, Tennis Enterprises, LLC has been successfully providing professional services at the Sunrise Tennis Club for over twenty (20) years; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sunrise and Tennis Enterprises, LLC have an existing Contract for Tennis Professional Services, which expires on June 14, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the City has negotiated rates, terms, and conditions with Tennis Enterprises, LLC for a new contract to ensure continuity of services.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby ratified and incorporated as the legislative intent of this Resolution.

Section 2. “Standard Contract No. C 26-03-04-VH between the City of Sunrise, Florida and Tennis Enterprises, LLC for Tennis Professional Services” (Contract) is hereby approved. A copy of the Contract is attached hereto and made a part of this Resolution as Exhibit A.

Section 3. Pursuant to Section 5-173(c)(5) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Sunrise Florida, the City’s formal bidding procedures are waived for good cause for the reasons set forth in this Resolution and accompanying Agenda Item Request.

Section 4. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the Contract.

Section 5. The Procurement Manager is hereby authorized to renew the Contract, and the City Manager is authorized to extend the Contract, in accordance with the terms of the approved Contract.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
