**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA, APPROVING A
“MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE FLORIDA
DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND SUNRISE FIRE RESCUE” FOR AN
EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES MATCHING GRANT; AND
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the City of Sunrise, through the Sunrise Fire Rescue Department, has been awarded a grant from the Florida Department of Health (FDOH) for the purchase of specialized software to be installed on two (2) cardiac monitors to assist in the assessment of patients' oxygen status, especially in cases of suspected carbon monoxide poisoning; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of the grant, the Sunrise Fire Rescue Department will receive \$7,164.79 from the FDOH, and is required to match \$2,388.26; and

WHEREAS, a Memorandum of Agreement between the parties is required for the acceptance of the grant.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. A “Memorandum of Agreement between The Florida Department of Health and Sunrise Fire Rescue” (Agreement) is hereby approved. A copy of the Agreement is attached hereto and made a part of this Resolution as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Fire Chief is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement.

Section 3. The Fire Chief, or designee, is hereby authorized to perform all acts required for the full performance of the Agreement, including executing any related documents, reports, extensions, or renewals. Any extension or renewal requires the approval of the City Attorney’s Office. Any material amendment to the Agreement requires approval of the City Commission. The Fire Chief shall provide the City Clerk with a copy of any executed extensions or renewals.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
