**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA, APPROVING “COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT NO. 26-18-03-WL BETWEEN THE CITY OF SUNRISE AND INSIGHT PUBLIC SECTOR, INC.” UNDER THE TERMS OF NASPO VALUEPOINT MASTER AGREEMENT NO. 23019 AND STATE OF FLORIDA ALTERNATIVE CONTRACT SOURCE NO. 43210000-23-NASPO-ACS FOR COMPUTER EQUIPMENT, PERIPHERALS, AND RELATED SERVICES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, Broward County utilizes a standardized system for countywide communications which requires updated communications equipment in City of Sunrise emergency vehicles to continue to provide emergency services; and

WHEREAS, after competitive procurement, the State of Minnesota, on behalf of NASPO ValuePoint Cooperative Purchasing Program, awarded NASPO ValuePoint Master Agreement No. 23019 for Computer Equipment, Peripherals, and Related Services to Panasonic Corporation of North America (Master Agreement); and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida, Department of Management Services, utilizing the Master Agreement, entered into Alternative Contract Source (ACS) No. 43210000-23-NASPO-ACS with Panasonic Corporation of North America (Florida Contract). Insight Public Sector, Inc. is an authorized dealer under the Florida Contract; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sunrise Fire Rescue Department is seeking to purchase the necessary equipment from Insight Public Sector, Inc. utilizing the Master Agreement and the Florida Contract.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. “Cooperative Agreement No. 26-18-03-WL between the City of Sunrise and Insight Public Sector, Inc.” (Agreement) under the terms of NASPO ValuePoint Master Agreement No. 23019 and State of Florida Alternative Contract Source No. 43210000-23-NASPO-ACS for Computer Equipment, Peripherals, and Related Services, is hereby approved. A copy of the Agreement is attached hereto and made a part of this Resolution as Exhibit A.

Section 2. Because these purchases will be made using existing governmental contracts, the City's formal bidding procedures are hereby waived pursuant to Section 5-173(c)(4) of the Code of the City of Sunrise, Florida.

Section 3. The Procurement Manager is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement.

Section 4. The Procurement Manager or designee hereby authorized to renew, amend, or extend the Agreement when renewed, amended or extended by the lead agency.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
