**RESOLUTION NO. 26-25**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CAPITAL PROJECTS DIRECTOR TO NEGOTIATE CONTINUING SERVICES AGREEMENTS WITH THE FOUR (4) TOP-RANKED FIRMS: CHEN MOORE AND ASSOCIATES, INC., STANTEC CONSULTING SERVICES INC., JOSEPH ROLES AND ASSOC., INC., AND BCC ENGINEERING, INC., FOR MISCELLANEOUS CIVIL ENGINEERING SERVICES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the City of Sunrise requires the services of qualified firms to provide miscellaneous civil engineering services; and

WHEREAS, the City issued a Request for Statements of Qualifications, RFQ 25-03-05-HR, to obtain the services of such firms; and

WHEREAS, the City received twenty three responses from interested engineering firms and City staff conducted an evaluation of the responses and shortlisted seven of the firms; and

WHEREAS, City staff requests authorization to negotiate continuing services agreements with the four top-ranked firms.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA:**

Section 1. Authorization is hereby granted for the Capital Projects Director to enter into negotiations for Continuing Services Agreements for Miscellaneous Civil Engineering Services with the first-ranked firm, Chen Moore and Associates, Inc., the second-ranked firm, Stantec Consulting Services Inc., the third-ranked firm, Joseph Roles and Assoc., Inc., and the fourth-ranked firm, BCC Engineering, Inc. In the event that Continuing Services Agreements cannot be negotiated with the four top-ranked firms, the Capital Projects Director is authorized to negotiate with the fifth-ranked firm, Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. If a successful agreement cannot be negotiated with the fifth-ranked firm, the Capital Projects Director is authorized to negotiate with the sixth-ranked firm, Calvin, Giordano & Associates, Inc. If a successful agreement cannot be negotiated with the seventh-ranked firm, the Capital Projects Director is authorized to negotiate with the seventh-ranked firm, Craven, Thompson & Associates, Inc. Should this process fail to produce four (4) satisfactory Continuing Services Agreements, then the City, at its discretion, will

either select additional firms from the original Request for Statements of Qualifications in the order of their competence or qualifications and continue negotiations until four (4) Continuing Services Agreements are reached, or the City will solicit a new Request for Statements of Qualifications.

Section 2. Upon successful completion of negotiations, City staff shall present the Continuing Services Agreements to the City Commission for approval.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
