A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF UTILITIES TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION FOR AN INTERSECTION CONVERSION PROJECT AS PART OF THE BROWARD COUNTY METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION'S ROADS FOR ECONOMIC VITALITY PROGRAM CYCLE 1 UNDER THE LOCAL AGENCY PROGRAM; EXPRESSING THE CITY'S SUPPORT FOR THE PROJECT AND APPLICATION; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A COMMITMENT LETTER; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) approved the Roads for Economic Vitality Program (REV) on July 9, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Mobility and Safety Dual Intersection Conversion Project, which proposes conversion of existing conventional intersections located at NW 94th Avenue & NW 42nd Street and Springtree Drive & NW 84th Avenue to roundabouts, will be evaluated and ranked by the MPO, and then vetted to determine programmability in accordance with the REV policies; and

WHEREAS, a resolution from the City of Sunrise Commission stating support for the project is required to establish funding eligibility; and

WHEREAS, federally funded projects off the state highway system are delivered using the federally mandated Local Agency Program (LAP) process; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sunrise commits to administer and deliver the project under LAP; and

WHEREAS, the LAP program is reimbursement-based as specified in the LAP agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sunrise commits to funding upfront costs for design, Construction Engineering and Inspection (CEI) services, and construction to be then reimbursed as per the LAP agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sunrise commits to program funding for construction contingency per the requirements of LAP; and

WHEREAS, the Mobility and Safety Dual Intersection Conversion Project, which proposes conversion of existing conventional intersections located at NW 94th Avenue & NW 42nd Street and Springtree Drive & NW 84th Avenue to roundabouts, will be constructed within the agency's right of way; and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the City of Sunrise to maintain or coordinate the maintenance of the roadways after the project's completion.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The foregoing Whereas clauses are hereby ratified and incorporated as the legislative intent of this Resolution.

Section 2. The City Commission hereby expresses its support for the project listed in Exhibit A and for the Roads for Economic Vitality Program (REV) grant application.

Section 3. The Director of Utilities, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute and submit the Roads for Economic Vitality Program grant application to the Broward County Metropolitan Planning Organization for the project listed in Exhibit A.

Section 4. Upon selection and programming of funding under this grant program, the City commits to amending its Capital Improvement Plan to include the selected project.

Section 5. The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute a letter committing to funding costs for project design, Construction Engineering and Inspection (CEI) services, construction contingency, and construction-related costs in excess of the \$5,000,000 cap per project for the proposed City project listed in Exhibit A. The letter shall further commit the City to providing applicable operation and maintenance costs.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
