**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA, APPROVING A
“FIRST AMENDMENT TO STANDARD CONTRACT C-22-57-08-WL
BETWEEN THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA AND BERMEX, INC.”
FOR METER READING SERVICES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
DATE.**

WHEREAS, on February 14, 2023, via Resolution No. 23-21, the Sunrise City Commission awarded Bid No. 22-57-08-WL and Standard Contract No. C-22-57-08-WL (Contract) for Meter Reading Services to Bermex, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the Contract was renewed for a one-year period, which extended the term through February 20, 2027; and

WHEREAS, the City is implementing Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) technology, which has significantly reduced and will continue to reduce the number of manually-read utility meters and associated field staffing requirements; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend the Contract to revise the compensation methodology from a per-read pricing structure to a fixed lump-sum staffing model based on the number of meter readers and validator/supervisor personnel assigned to better reflect the City’s current operational needs; and

WHEREAS, the amended pricing structure will provide the City with operational flexibility to decrease staffing levels as AMI implementation progresses, while clarifying that the City does not guarantee any minimum quantity of meter reads, routes, staffing assignments, or compensation under the Contract.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. A “First Amendment to Standard Contract C-22-57-08-WL between the City of Sunrise, Florida and Bermex, Inc.” (First Amendment) is hereby approved. A copy of the First Amendment is attached hereto and made part of this Resolution as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Procurement Manager or designee is hereby authorized to execute the First Amendment.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
