A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA, APPOINTING A LOCAL HEARING OFFICER TO CONDUCT HEARINGS FOR NOTICES OF VIOLATIONS ISSUED PURSUANT TO SECTION 316.1896, FLORIDA STATUTES, FOR SCHOOL ZONE SPEED VIOLATIONS; DESIGNATING A PUBLIC SERVICE AIDE TO SERVE AS THE CLERK TO THE LOCAL HEARING OFFICER; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, school zones are designated portions of streets or roads located within a school area that are subject to reduced speed limits at certain times of day; and

WHEREAS, speeding in school zones presents a threat to the public health, safety, and welfare, especially the safety of children attending schools in the City; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 2023-174, Laws of Florida (the "Act"), created Section 316.1896, Florida Statutes, and authorized counties and municipalities to use speed detection systems to enforce school zone speed limits at certain times of the day; and

WHEREAS, the Act authorizes local administrative hearings for notices of violations connected with the use of speed detection systems as traffic infraction detectors to enforce Chapter 316, the Florida Uniform Traffic Code; and

WHEREAS, the use of a Local Hearing Officer provides a process for contested notices of violations issued for school zone speed violations separate from the traffic court process; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to appoint Brenda Di Ionia to serve as the Local Hearing Officer for contested school zone speed violations.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The City Commission of the City of Sunrise, Florida hereby appoints Brenda Di Ionia as the Local Hearing Officer for the process of hearing contested notices of violations issued for school zone speed violations at the rate of \$250.00 per hour, or any part thereof, with a two (2) hour minimum for each hearing.

Section 2. The City Commission of the City of Sunrise, Florida further designates a Public Service Aide employed by the City to serve as the Clerk to the Local Hearing Officer.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
